Almost every recent overview of pronunciation laments the previous state of the field, while acknowledging an explosion of research. Some important names are:

Derwing, T. M., & Munro, M. J., who continue to be active in pronunciation research, individually and together. The PronSIG magazine **Speak Out** (Feb 2025) has an interview with Derwing and Munro covering the genesis of their seminal 1997 paper.

Isaacs, T., Trofimovich, P., and **Saito, K.** who are key researchers in the field and have published extensively, individually and in collaboration.

John Levis, a very influential figure. *Intelligibility, oral communication, and the teaching of pronunciation* is a detailed discussion of the whole field, synthesising research into a very wide range of issues and L1s.
